

VISITORS – PLEASE READ

We want you to enjoy your visit with your loved one while also keeping everyone safe! While visiting, please adhere to the following rules - the facility maintains the right to ask any visitors who violate these rules to leave the facility immediately.

- Do not visit if you have any Covid-like symptoms listed on the screening form.
- Do not visit if you have been exposed to a confirmed positive person in the last 14 days.
- Must wear a mask always covering your nose & mouth while in the Facility.
- Go directly to the visitation area or resident room only - do not linger in hallways or other unauthorized areas.
- Maintain 6-foot distancing from all other residents & visitors at all times. If visiting in the resident room with a roommate present, please be respectful and limit visitors to 2 at a time if possible - may rotate visitors if there are more than 2 visitors.
- No limit to the number of visitors if visiting a resident in a private room or visitation area if space allows.
- If your loved one is in quarantine precautions, visits are not advised but are still allowed while understanding the risks of potential exposure.
- If visiting in a quarantine room, it is recommended that in addition to your mask you apply a face shield (ask at check-in) as well as gown & gloves before entering the room (gown & gloves available outside of the room). Signs should be posted outside these rooms with instructions on applying & removing the gown & gloves. Please ask a staff member for assistance if needed. Gown & gloves must be removed before exiting the room and must wash hands or use alcohol gel before exiting the room. Also, dispose of the face shield.
- Always perform hand hygiene using soap & water or alcohol gel before leaving a resident room or visitation area and upon exiting the facility. Alcohol gel dispensers are located inside and outside of each resident room, as well as at various locations throughout the facility.
